



Information on the possibility of writing the OIIQ professional exam

Applicants for registration must meet, among other things, the examination requirements. All applicants for NB registration must take and pass the NCLEX-RN exam, with the exception of those who have passed a licensing exam recognized by another Canadian province or territory. New Brunswick graduates who meet all of the eligibility requirements for registration, except for passing the registration exam, may meet this requirement by writing and passing the registration exam in any province or territory in Canada. Currently, only Quebec has a registration exam other than the NCLEX-RN. This exam is recognized by CNNB.

It is important to mention that this option is available to both French and English speaking graduates and that the OIIQ (Ordre des infirmières et infirmiers du Québec) exam can be taken in the language of your choice.

The OIIQ exam is offered twice a year, in September and March. Information regarding the dates and locations of the exam sessions and the registration deadline can be found here:
